Hub RFP Issued

The Statewide HIE has reached an important milestone in issuing its Request For Proposals for Secure Hub services to the vendor community. The Hub is the core infrastructure for the Statewide HIE and will allow practices, hospitals, payers, public health, consumers and others to exchange health information in a secure and cost effective manner. This will assist all parties to improve patient care and the health of the community. OneHealthPort is working closely with the HIE Leadership Group, its Technical Advisory Group and the HCA to review vendor responses and select the most qualified bidder. The goal is to complete the selection process by October and have initial Hub capability ready for implementation early in 2011 to support providers interested in achieving meaningful use. All qualified vendors are encouraged to bid by completing the Intent to Respond form below and submitting the required RFP documents according to the timeline.
