Receive a standard output file containing NPI (National Provider Identifier) numbers and other demographic information for all Northwest physicians and healthcare organization with information stored in the directory.

WHY SUBSCRIBE?

Instead of going to each physician and health care organization separately to gather NPI and other demographic information, the Northwest NPI Service allows you to collect all of this information with one file download.

- Receive all information in a single, common file.
- Receive information in an easy to access, easy to use, standardized format.
- Save physicians and health care organizations you work with time and hassle.
- Download updated files as more NPI information is input.

The Northwest NPI Service allows physicians and healthcare organizations in the Northwest to store NPI (National Provider Identifier) information and other important numbers. This community-wide directory provides an easy way for providers to share information with health plans, health systems, and other providers that need NPI numbers to comply with HIPAA regulations.

Collecting NPI Information Quickly and Easily

All OneHealthPort subscribers with a secure ID may search the directory for individual records for free. Organizations that require information on a large number of providers may also purchase an annual subscription to download a standard output file with all records contained in the Northwest NPI Service. The file is updated weekly and can be downloaded as often as desired.

The annual subscription is ideal for health plans and health systems that need to collect large numbers of provider identifiers and demographics—including taxonomy codes and descriptions. It is also ideal for health care provider organizations that need to collect large numbers of referring provider NPI numbers.

Collecting Data to Create a Comprehensive NPI Directory

OneHealthPort is actively encouraging all physicians and healthcare organizations to contribute their NPI and demographic information to the Northwest NPI Service. We make it easy with a number of *free* options, including:

- Direct data entry using a Web browser-based application.
- File uploading using standardized data specification for larger organizations with too many records to enter manually.
