





# Vision For The Clinical Portal



- Aggregation of clinical and claims data provides a more complete history on patient:
  - Social Determinants of Health
  - Advanced Directives
- Simplified transition of care:
  - Less “re-telling of history”
  - Customizable alerts to care team for care transitions
- Compliance with sponsored initiatives
- Meaningful Use reports

- Provide feedback on what works and what doesn't.
- Provide input on how we can make it better and provide more value.



# What To Expect Of The Clinical Portal

- There is about two years of claims data in the Clinical Portal. If clinical data is sparse for a patient, view claims data to help supplement clinical information.
- Not all patients will have clinical data. Over time, as more providers submit data, there will be a more complete longitudinal health record for patients – however, this will take time to build...

# Pre-Requisites for using the Clinical Portal

To use the Clinical Portal your organization needs:

- Policies for designating individuals to access the Clinical Portal, assignment of CDR access roles for those users, and use of personal mobile devices.
  - Designated individuals for Clinical Portal use that do not have an SSO account will need to be nominated to become a SSO Subscriber.

# Clinical Portal Access Requires Multi-Factor Authentication

## What is Multi-Factor Authentication?

- Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) adds another layer of security to verify a user's identity by combining two factors that identify an individual.
  - What the user knows (such as a username and password)
  - What the user has (such as a phone or tablet device that generates a token)
  - What the user is (such as a fingerprint, iris scan etc.)\*
- Not all applications require MFA. Users will be prompted for MFA only when they try to access an application that requires MFA.
- Currently the Clinical Portal requires users to use Google Authenticator as the MFA.

## What is Google Authenticator?

- Google Authenticator is a free App that is downloaded to a user's mobile or tablet device that generates a six to eight-digit passcode which users must provide in addition to their username and password to login.
  - The App is free and does not use cell phone minutes or data
  - Users do not need to create Google account to use Google Authenticator

*\*NOTE: Currently OneHealthPort does not use this type of identity verification to authenticate users.*





# Viewing Clinical Data

# What to Expect When Viewing Clinical Data

- Data is view only – you **cannot add or edit** any of the data in the Clinical Portal.
- You **may see duplicate data**; because of how organizations' systems are set to submit the data.
- **Documents** in the patient record may contain more information than what is viewable in the sections.
- If you **see codes instead of descriptions** in the sections of the patient's record, this means the data was submitted that way by the organization.
