Legend for the Organized Change Log:

*1 - When the cell in the TX column (transaction) is greyed out and **Review/Response** are Bolded - the change applies to both the Review related loop-segment and the Response related loop segment

Explanatory Note:

The changes to the 8010v of this transaction are, for the most part, refinements to code values and usage requirements.

- #1 6 are specifically called out because:
 - a.) the functions are likely to be increasingly important to the usage of the transaction (#1 Attachments, #2 BHT / HL),
 - b.) the functions represent a new usage of the transaction (#5 Drug Auth, #6 Workman's Compensation) or
 - c.) there are numerous listed changes within a segment(s) (#3 CR/CRC & #4 Diagnosis) though not all may be relevant.

The remainder of the changes, which are the bulk of the document, are listed in the "278-342 Organized Change Log" as 'Clarify Usage – Misc'

1. Attachments

The 8010v attachment changes are primarily related to the use of the PWK, i.e. new Code Value of 'FT-File Transfer' and new segment note.

Though these changes are few, they are highlighted due to the likely importance of this transaction and the 275 -Attachments transaction by the time that the new version is mandated

2. BHT / HL Segment

The 8010v BHT/HL Segment changes primarily relate to:

- Removing "AT" code value of BHT02 so as to be explicit about whether or not follow-on responses are to be expected.
- Outlining situational usage requirements, depending upon the value of UM01 & UM03
- Providing instructions for how to order the HL segments

3. CR / CRC Segment

The 8010v CR / CRC Segment changes primarily relate to:

- Using new / different code values to be more specific about the condition being reported
- Deleting code values because they do not relate to the condition being reported
- Being more specific about the conditions under which usage of the segment /data element is required

4. Diagnosis (HI Segment)

The 8010v Diagnosis changes primarily relate to:

- Adding a segment to provide additional diagnosis information to clarify services, rather than sending with MSG segment.
- Restricting the use of MSG segments for diagnosis code information
- Specifying conditions under which usage of the segments are required

5. Drug Auth (DRA Segment)

The 8010v Drug Auth changes primarily relate to:

- Adding a segment (since the 5010) to the 2000F loop to specify the drug for which authorization is being requested
- Using new / different code values (likely relating to the difference between 6020 and 7030)
- Specifying changes to conditions under which usage of the segments are required (likely relating to the difference between 6020 and 7030)

6. Workman's Compensation

The 8010v Workman's Comp changes primarily relate to using the transaction for Workman's Compensation exchanges where there is a case number rather than a patient number that uniquely identifies a patient and their coverage plan. In these cases, the subscriber type is a non-person entity (NM102='2'), the TIN of the agency will be used (NM108='FI') and the case number for the subscriber / dependent will be used to identify the patient (REF01='Y4').
