

OneHealthPort HIE – OneHealthPort Provider Directory

*Share and Receive Up-to-Date Provider Directory
Information Including Direct Email Addresses*

The next step in the evolution toward a community-wide electronic provider directory is now available to users of the OneHealthPort HIE. The OneHealthPort Provider Directory (OPD) serves as a central resource to:

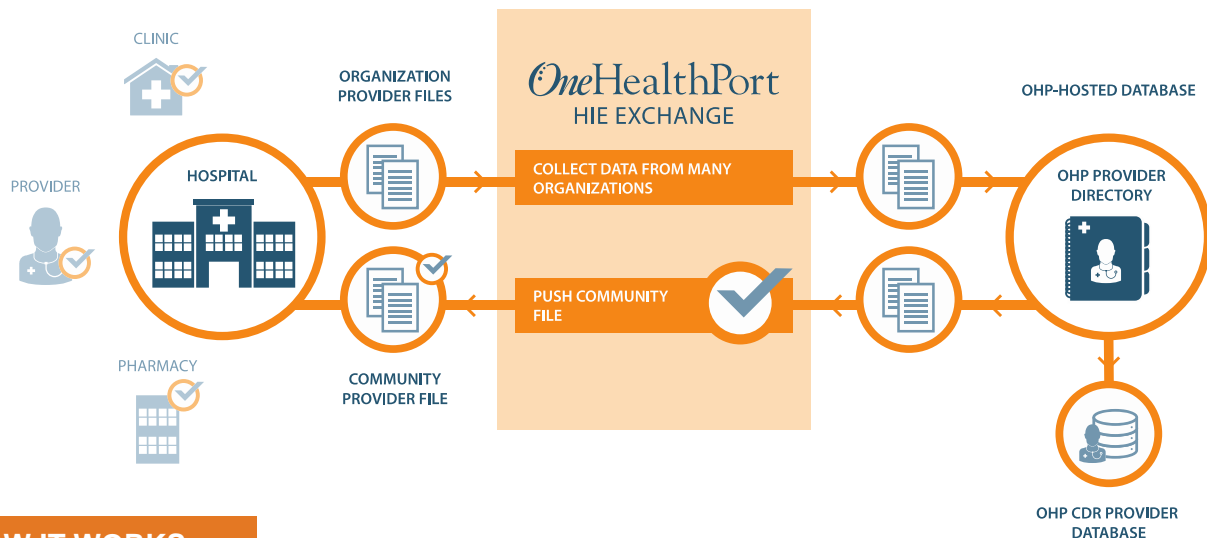
- Find “direct” email addresses for entities or practitioners to use in sending direct secure messages in compliance with Meaningful Use Stage 2 requirements
- Meet provider directory requirements for any organization contributing to the HIE Clinical Data Repository

With the OPD, organizations can both share and receive current practitioner information that can be integrated into internal systems and refreshed as information is updated.

This transaction is available to all contracted HIE clinical trading partners without additional cost.

KEY BENEFITS

- Allows organizations to easily receive current provider data in a standard format with an automated process
- Supports organizations’ ability to meet Meaningful Use Stage 2 requirements for transmitting direct secure messages
- Smaller organizations and provider groups can look-up and/or add individual provider direct addresses on the OneHealthPort website
- Allows submission of provider directory files any time based on trading partner needs, schedules and capacity
- Provides immediate acknowledgement of file delivery and feedback on success or reason for failure in a deferred response



HOW IT WORKS

- Contributing organizations gather directory information according to the OPD Implementation Guide
- Information can be shared on a system-to-system basis or via a secure web portal for users that do not have an automated option
- Web portal users can add, update or look up an individual practitioner or organization record at any time using their OneHealthPort login
- OneHealthPort manages the OPD database to aggregate the data
- The OPD service pushes provider directory information with Direct-address information to trading partners who want aggregated community information
- The OPD service pushes provider directory information to the CDR on behalf of participating organizations (no additional action or exchange is required by the organization)
- Any HIE-participating organization can subscribe to receive a scheduled feed of the aggregated directory information
